



## **2026 Fort Saskatchewan Minor Sports STRIKE Scholarship**

*In partnership with STRIKE Energy and their generous annual donation towards our operations, FSMSA would like to extend this scholarship opportunity to its members.*



**Purpose:** To recognize and reward senior high school students that currently participate in FSMSA activities and encourage them to pursue education after high school, and to support past FSMSA Participants who are currently engaged with post-secondary or technical studies, at their annual Golf Tournament Dinner.

STRIKE Gold Scholarship: \$1000 awarded to applicants

STRIKE Silver Scholarship: \$500 awarded to applicants

STRIKE Bronze Scholarship: \$250 awarded to applicants

**Eligibility:** Students with **full or part time enrolment** at a **post-secondary institution (including technical schools)** in **Fall 2026 or Winter 2027**.

Awarded scholarships will **prefer current high school students** graduating in June 2026, however any student that has participated in FSMSA and is receiving education after high school is eligible for the 2026 Strike Scholarship. Proof of enrolment at a post secondary or technical institution will be required before monetary disbursement.

**Applicants must have participated in at least 1 season of FSMSA sport** to be considered for the Scholarship. Applicants with greater involvement within FSMSA will be preferred.

- Involvement in the FSMSA sport includes registered players, coaches, game officials and volunteers. FSMSA Sports include: baseball, fastball, gymnastics, hockey, judo, lacrosse, ringette, soccer, basketball within Fort Saskatchewan.



**Selection:** Applicants will be selected based on a combination of their academic success, athletic accomplishments, and volunteerism / community involvement. Selection will prefer current graduating high school students. Students who were FSMSA participants in the past and are currently receiving education after high school may also be selected.

**Requirements:**

1. Your most recent high school / post secondary transcript. Students' final 2026 school year report cards or proof of high school graduation are not required.
2. A letter of recommendation / reference from a volunteer coordinator, school teacher, principal, coach, etc.
3. Short responses to a number of eligibility questions.
4. A long answer response (500 words or less) to the following question:

***How has the leadership, growth, perseverance, and dedication you experienced within sport prepared you for post-secondary education?***
