5. Purpose

The purpose of the Fundraising Bond is to support association-wide initiatives and help keep hockey affordable for all families by offsetting rising operational costs.

6. Scope of Application

- This policy applies to all registered FSMH players.
- This policy relates only to **association-level fundraising** and does not include team fundraising activities.

7. Fundraising Bond Requirement

A **\$50.00 fundraising bond per player** will be collected at the time of registration

8. Family Calculation (Multiple Players)

- For families with multiple registered players, fundraising totals will be combined at the family level.
- Total ticket sales will be applied across all players within the same household.

9. Earning Back the Bond

- Families can earn back up to **100% of their fundraising bond** by participating in FSMH-approved fundraising initiatives.
- Currently, this includes **online 50/50 ticket sales** assigned to the player.
- Each player must sell at least \$50 of FSMH online 50/50 tickets to be eligible for a refund.

10. Refund Timeline

- Fundraising bond refunds will be processed by the last day of April of the current season.

- Refunds will be issued via:
 - Original payment method (credit card),
 - Cheque, or
 - Registration credit (at FSMH discretion)

11. Non-Participation

If no eligible fundraising activity is completed, the bond will be retained by FSMH and used to support association operations.
